

General terms and conditions

for renting the exhibition "Women Inventors"

Description of the exhibition: The exhibition includes the following exhibits: Thirteen display stands (roll-up banners) in the format 85 x 200 cm (rolled out), consisting of one intro and 12 displays with presentations of inventors (inventions):

- Barbe-Nicole Clicquot (Champagne rocking rack)
- Florence Nightingale (Pie chart)
- Sarah H. Bancroft / Sarah W. Tucker (Bath chair); Martine Kempf (Voice operated invalid chair)
- Kate Jenkins (life jacket)
- Caresse Crosby (BH); Julie Newmar (Bodyshape)
- Käthe Paulus (Packed parachute)
- Hedy Lamarr (Spread spectrum and frequency hopping technology)
- Dr. Maria Telkes / Eleanor Raymond (Sun-powered house)
- Virginia Apgar (Apgar Score)
- Mary Anderson (Windscreen wiper)
- Grace Hopper (Compiler)
- Ada Lovelace (Algorithm)

The exhibition "Women Inventors" can be rented completely or in parts.

The roll-up banners are equipped with poles and packaging covers which must be returned as well. The title of the exhibition may be used by the organizing institution for advertising purposes.

Rental fees: For the rent of the exhibition "Women Inventors" a fee will be charged for the duration of up to four weeks. The estimated total fee is up to arrangement between lender and borrower; for universities, schools and other facilities of the Public service and for periods longer than four weeks special conditions apply. Additional shipping costs and VAT are applicable.

Period of lending: The exhibition "Women Inventors" can be rented for a minimum of two days and a maximum of four weeks (standard period) at standard prices. It is recommended to book the desired period in advance.

Transport: The shipment from and to Furtwangen University should be organized with one Parcel service and at the expense of the borrower. You get thirteen roll-up banners packed in two boxes of size 40 x 30 x 95 cm; when ordering less than eight roll-up banners the shipping is in one carton.

Insurance: Damage, theft or loss of individual roll-up banners are to be reimbursed by the borrower. Obtaining insurance is not required. Before the exhibition leaves our house, all roll-up banners are individually examined. We ship roll-up banners only in perfect condition. Should the borrower detect any damage upon receiving and unpacking the roll-up banners, the borrower is obligated to inform immediately the Netzwerk F.I.T about it.
